CanSkate CanSkate offers the best curriculum in Canada. Our flagship learn-to-skate program has taught millions of Canadians to reach their recreational and competitive goals on the ice.

The CanSkate program is geared to beginners of all ages...children, adults, newcomers to Canada and athletes with a disability (AWAD). Whether you are looking to improve basic skating skills for figure skating, hockey, ringette, or speed skating, or wish to skate for recreation, fitness, or fun, CanSkate will get you there.

Conducted in a fun, friendly environment, the CanSkate program highlights a comprehensive series of balance, control, and agility skills, using a nationally tested and proven curriculum that supports skater success in developing stronger basic skills on the ice.

Millions of Canadians, including World and Olympic figure skating champions and National Hockey League stars, have taken their first steps on the ice with the CanSkate program. Offered at clubs and skating schools across Canada and delivered by NCCP coaches, CanSkate will help you realize your skating goals.

CanSkaters will need:

- Pair of good quality skates, either figure skates or hockey skates
- Helmet, a mask/cage is not necessary
- Warm clothing, layers which allow for movement and do not restrict the skaters but keep them warm
- Mittens or gloves

CanSkate Registration Fees

- One day per week \$225.00
- Two days per week \$350.00

Cost includes SkateCanada registration and insurance, ice time and coaching.



StarSkate The STAR 1-5 program offers the best-in-class figure skating curriculum in Canada, targeting athletes looking for a future in the sport. Taught by Skate Canada NCCP coaches, the program introduces participants to the basic figure skating elements to create the foundation for singles, pairs, ice dance and synchronized skating.

All skaters in this program must have passed CanSkate Stage 6 or equivalent. Skaters may be any age.

STAR 6- Gold is an assessment and event structure for skaters who completed the STAR 1-5 Program. This structure builds on the skills acquired in STAR 1-5 and introduces skaters to more advanced figure skating elements.

StarSkaters will need:

- A supportive pair of leather figure skates with toe picks
- Clothing that allows for flexability and freedom of movement (no jeans!)
- A yoga matt

StarSkate Registration Fees

- One day per week \$235.00
- Two days per week \$360.00

Cost includes Skate Canada registration and insurance, ice time. Coaching fees for private and group lessons are extra and will be invoiced directly by the club to the parents at the end of each month.

Schedule

The 2022/2023 skate season begins on October 17, 2022, and culminates with our Ice Show on February 17th, 2023. The StarSkaters will continue until March 10th to prepare for the end of year test days. Lessons are on Mondays and Friday, times are as follows:

- Parent and Tot: 4:15-4:45
- CanSkate 4:15-5:00
- StarSkate 5:00-7:00
- Stretch Class 7:00-7:30

A schedule will be posted on our club bulletin board at the rink. There will also be a version available on our website and through Team App. Parents will be notified of cancellations or changes to skating times through Team App.

ASC'S coaches are certified or in training under the national Coaching Certification Program (NCCP). This year's coaches are Tasha Hoff (CanSkate & StarSkate), Justine Bamford (CanSkate), Kimber Bader (StarSkate), and Michelle Marcenko (StarSkate). The CanSkate program also requires on-ice aids to help our little ones to get around and complete activities. On- ice aids are volunteers and are members of our StarSkate program.
